

DEPARTMENT OF **LAW**



1. Overview of the Department

Department of Law of Green University of Bangladesh (GUB) started its journey in the year 2003. It aims to accomplish excellence in educating students, nurturing legal scholarship, serving community and ultimately fostering justice. The Department is committed to ensure comprehensive learning environment both in and outside classroom with a view to providing excellent first-hand academic knowledge and skills essential to embark on the practice of law and legal research. We offer two degree programmes i.e. Bachelor of Laws with Honours -LLB (Hons) and Master of Laws (LL M). The objective of the LL.B. (Hons.) programme is to produce qualified law graduates for all job opportunities in the socio-legal fields of Bangladesh and abroad. The LL. M. programme aims at offering the law graduates a high profile up-to-date curriculum focusing on research and learning in different specialized areas of domestic and international law.

It started its journey with few enrolled students. With the passage of time, student enrollment increased substantially and at present there are more than 300 students pursuing undergraduate and post graduate studies. The department has 8 full time faculties with one Ph.D. holder. In Addition, Professor Dr. Stephen Hobe, Director Institute of Air and Space Law, University of Cologne, Germany is working here as Honorary Professor. For the practical teaching-learning, lawyers and judges are employed as part-time faculty from bar and bench of Supreme Court and sub-ordinate Courts of Bangladesh. Most of the faculty members of department of law have membership in Bangladesh Bar Council, different Bar Association including Supreme Court Bar Association. At present, the department has 1 Associate Professor, 2 Assistant Professors two senior lecturers and 2 lecturers.

We are proud to announce that the Law department has established the Centre for Air and Space Law, the country's first and only centre for research and practical education on Air and Space law. It arranged country's first international conference on space law. It has signed MoU with Institute of Air and Space Law, University of Cologne, Germany.

The Dept. of Law established Moot Court Society in 2013 with a view that students may acquire practical knowledge on customary behaviors of lawyers in court-room and other associated professional ethics that is expected of a lawyer of good standing. To foster legal research, the Department established Research Cell in 2015. The Cell conducts departmental research activities and advice on research strategies, initiatives and innovation. The Cell organized different seminars, symposiums and workshops individually or in collaboration with different organizations like Mohila Porishad, Ain O Salish Kendro, and Bangladesh Women Lawyers Association etc. The Cell publishes Law Bulletin in each trimester and contributes by writing articles in Green University Review of Social Science. The department offers special aid for the preparation of Bangladesh Judicial Service, Bangladesh Bar Council and other competitive exams by arranging special classes, model tests, workshops and mock viva.

To ensure quality education, Ministry of Education with the assistance of World Bank has undertaken a Higher Education Enhancement Project (HEQEP) supervised by University Grants Commission (UGC). As per guideline of UGC for implementing Self-Assessment (SA) process, the Department of Law has already arranged a number of workshops, seminars and training programs for capacity building by inviting resource persons from different institutions. The main purpose of SA is to review the existing processes being practiced and take up strategic plans for improvement of the program. We are delighted to share that as per report of the External (Foreign) Peer Review Team, the department placed VERY GOOD position.

Apart from regular academic duties, in 2017, Department of Law conducted as many as 50 activities including seminars, conferences, study tours, social activities etc. We do believe that the Department of Law will establish themselves amongst the top law schools of Bangladesh very soon.

2. Conferences, Seminars and Workshops Organized by the Departments.

Workshop on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for Existing Students

On 3-4 January 2017, the Self-Assessment Committee (SAC) of Department of law organized back to back series of workshops on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for existing students for tutoring the way of giving feedback on different segments and performance of the



department with their recommendations. The SAC members, faculties of the department were present there.

Workshop on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for Alumni of Law (Phase -I)

On 6 January 2017, the SAC of the Department arranged another workshop on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for Alumni. More than 80 alumni participated in the program and gave their feedbacks for the development of department. The SAC members, faculties of the department were present there.



Workshop on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for Faculty Members Law

On 18 January 2017, the SAC organized workshop for faculty members on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for sharing the way of giving feedback on different segments and performance of the department with their recommendations. The SAC members, faculties of the department were present there.



Workshop on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for Non-Academics of Law

The SAC of the Department on 8th February 2017, organized a workshop for non-Academic members of the university to get their opinions for the development of the department. Registrar, Finance Director, Controller of Exams and other high officials participated in the workshop and gave their suggestion for overall promotion of the department. The SA members, faculties of the department were present there.

Workshop on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for Alumni of Law (Phase -II)

As the continuation of 1st phase, the SAC of the Department organized 2nd phase of the workshop on Self-Assessment Survey Tools for Alumni on 1st June 2017. More than 30 alumni attended the workshop and provide their opinions for promotion of the department.



Workshop on Art of the Formulating Quality Question

To ensure quality education in legal field, it is necessary to formulate analytical and creative questions for the students. To do this, the very first thing is to train the faculty members about the arts of formulating quality question. In this context, Department of Law organized day- long workshop on 7 August 2017 to train the existing faculty members. Recent approaches for question formulation including Bloom's taxonomy were discussed and faculty members were asked to formulate question accordingly. The programme was facilitated by Prof. Dr. Golam Samdani Fakir, Vice Chancellor of Green University.

Workshop on How to Write a Research Proposal

Research is an integral part of legal study. The students of LLM and LLB (Hons) final semesters need to submit their research Monograph as a part of their degree requirement. However, many law students fail to submit standard research monograph because of their lack of knowledge in research writing. Therefore, the Department organized a workshop with senior students on the techniques of research proposal writing on 11 August 2017. Dr. Parvez Ahmed, Associate Professor of Law discussed on this topic. Dr. Md. Noor Mohammad, chairperson of the Department chaired the session.



Programme with Bangladesh Mohila Porishod on Thought of the Youth for Establishing Women's Right

Department with the support of Bangladesh Mohila Porishod arranged a programme on 18 August 2017 to know the views of the youth for establishing women's rights in Bangladesh. It was a very lively session. Experts of Bangladesh Mohila Porishod presented the current situation of women in the country and asked the students of the Department regarding the possible ways and means for ensuring women rights. The programme was concluded with some concrete decisions. Honourable VC, Pro-VC, Chairperson and

other faculty members of the Department were also present in this programme.

Workshops on Teaching Learning and Curriculum Development of Law Department (phase-I and II)

Method of Teaching Learning and Evaluation has considerably been changed in 21st century especially in tertiary level. The theory of Andragogy needs to be adopted rather than that of Pedagogy. The curriculum must be adapted with the need basis of 21st century and requirement of job market. It requires every faculty members of GUB to be acquainted with the updated method of teaching, learning and curriculum format. At this vein, the Department of Law arranged two workshops on Teaching Learning and Curriculum Development of Law Department on 27.09.2018 and 28.12.2017. These workshops aimed to address the requirement of preparing the updated method of teaching, learning and curriculum format. All faculty members participated in these workshops and these were facilitated by the Institutional Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of GUB.

3. Award and Achievements

Dr. Parvez Ahmed got Scholarship from Hague Academy of International Law

It is a matter of pride that Dr. Parvez Ahmed, Associate Professor, Department of Law had received the prestigious scholarship from the Hague Academy of International Law, the Hague, the Netherlands for doing his research on Space Law. He became the 1st Bangladeshi to do such research in Hague Academy. He attended an intensive research



on Outer Space and Developing Countries under the theme “50 Years of Space Law-Space Law in 50 Years”. The Hague Academy of International Law is considered as the best law academy of Europe. Total 24 researchers were divided equally in two groups on the basis of medium of instruction i.e. English and French. In his group, he guided by the legendary Air and Space law professor of Germany, Prof. Stephan Hobe.. Participants from the USA, Brazil, Peru, Germany, Russia, Italy, India, Austria, China, Japan, Belgium and Bangladesh (self) attended this 3 week long research workshop. Dr. Ahmed’s research area was “Space Law and Developing Countries”. The objective of his research was among others to find out the possibilities of the developing countries for development with the application of space technology and law.

The brilliant students of Department of Law received Vice Chancellor’s Certificates and Dean’s Certificates for their outstanding performance in their preceding semesters. University handed over these certificates in a ceremonial programme on 27 July 2017.
